GUEST SPEAKER: Dr. Susan Grey

- Summarized feedback from exit poll
- At bus garage, lift must be replaced
- Priorities set based on input provided
- Cut back on scale of all other proposals
- Discussed various changes to the auditorium
- No changes to cafeteria
- Bay Trail
 - No new media center
 - Increase size of library
 - Less internal renovation
- Elementary Level
 - \$4 or \$5 million worth or work
 - Primarily HVAC
- Athletic Facility
 - Also scaled back
 - Includes rearranging bleachers in West gym
 - New backboards
 - New track

- Outside of current stadium
- Another field inside this track
- Does not include artificial turf
- Proposition to board will include the turf and new bleachers
 - Turf cost \$800,000
 - Lights \$200,000 – not desired based on feedback
- Perhaps at Sept 19 meeting, the proposition can be adopted
- The Board and Dr. Gray are prohibited by law to ask the community to vote YES
 - Citizens can do this door-to-door, pamphlets, etc
- About 8 weeks between board vote and community vote
- New vote scheduled for November 14
 - Their will be proposals attached to this vote
 - Choices voters can make
 - One choice will be the Athletic Facilities proposal as determined by the Board

FUNDRAISING: Patty Vermilion and Sue DelPozzo

- Varsity Gold Card
 - 24 businesses on Gold Card – only 5 outside Penfield
 - Any sport wishing to sell cards can sign up
 - Each athlete will receive 10 cards to be sold for \$10 each
 - The individual sport will receive \$4 for each card sold and Global will receive \$1
 - Overall, if 1000 cards are sold, each sport will receive an extra dollar
 - \$5 to individual sport, \$1 to Global
 - Athletes can return any unsold cards
- Patty organized a pilot Scrip program for the Cross Country teams. If the pilot does well, the Scrip program could be expanded to become a fundraiser for the Global Boosters next winter.
