REVIEW OF MINUTES:

- Jim Howe motioned
- Susanne Perrone seconded
- Minutes accepted

OFFICER'S REPORTS:

PRESIDENT: Tom VanThof

- Tom feels we really haven't properly supported Pete with the Golf Tournament, which will be Monday, August 6, 2007
- Smaller sports don't necessarily enter a team. Trying to get full participation from all 28 varsity sports
 - Any sport can enter more than one team
- There are usually about 36 golf teams, need 28 teams to break even
- Looking for volunteers to be on a committee to plan the tournament AND people to help the day of the tournament
- Should have subcommittees for other jobs also.
- Things for committee to consider:
 - Should we solicit bids from other golf clubs rather than continuing to hold it at Shadow Lake?
 - This would need to be done by end of March
 - Should we raise the fee from \$360 to \$400 per team?

VICE PRESIDENT: Mick Schoenberger

- The minutes from January's Global meeting are up on the website
- Mick has received one email from the website.
 - Person wants to be contacted by someone from fundraising – give information to Patty
- Pete would like to see some procedure for making sure all information is up to date, making sure old information is deleted when it becomes obsolete.

- Distributed financial statements asking everyone to check for accuracy
- Please give Chuck the benefit of time rather than rush requests
- Chuck needs to be given as much notice as possible to get payments sent out
- Do not drop off check requests at school, mail them to his home, which has been working very well so far this year
- Get questions or information to him via work email rather than home email
- Currently have over \$10,000, some needed for MVP/MIP luncheon
- All bills have been paid

STUDENT REP: Matt Plakosh

- Kids excited about seeing new changes and additions now that the facilities project vote has passed

VARSITY CLUB REP: not selected yet

COMMITTEE CHAIR REPORTS:

CONCESSIONS: Marie Mahany (not present), Barb Babiarz (not present), and Anand Choudri (not present)

- Girl's softball talking about purchasing leftover concessions

FUNDRAISING: Patty Vermilion and Sue DelPozzo

- Patty reported that SCRIP is \$100 short of breaking even, but has a lot of cards left
 - This is the last push from Global's point-of-view, then back to track
 - Having discussed SCRIP at the winter parent/athlete meeting, advertising in the PHS Observer and the Trail Blazer, there were only about 40-50 total orders
 - Tom suggested Patty get Deb an inventory of what cards we have left
- Pete, Tom, Patty, and Sue started talking more about fundraising
 - See President's report above for specifics on the Golf Tournament
- Other fundraising ideas would be a Casino Night or Monte Carlo Night
 - There are specific rules that would need to be followed
 - Could include entrance fee, raffles, silent auction, some games

FACILITIES: Jim Howe

- Still accepting request until end of February.
 - Has currently not received any

ATHLETIC DIRECTOR: Pete Shambo

- Meeting with architect, Dr. Gray, Mr. Sansucci, about athletic part of the facilities project
- Discussed how there are issues that individual sports will need to address and consider targeting for fundraising. Some issues include:
 - Baseball: new dugouts, no new backstop
 - Boy's soccer: David Elliot clock will need to be moved
 - Field hockey: goals with wheels
 - Pete will make a running list
- Dr. Gray offered to invite a booster rep on the planning committee, but Pete turned it down.
- Encourages reps to continue talking to coaches about the needs of individual sports
- Good winter sports season
- Spring sports begin March 5 for Lacrosse, March 12 for rest of sports

OLD BUSINESS:

- With regard to athletes and parents of athletes who are hearing impaired, two interpreters will be needed if there is continuous talking for an hour or more.
 - May only need one interpreter at a banquet
 - Consider motion at next month's meeting if global should fund this.
