Meeting was called to order at 7:33 PM

REVIEW OF MINUTES:

- Susanne Perrone motioned
- Patty Vermilion seconded
- Minutes accepted

OFFICER'S REPORTS:

PRESIDENT: Tom VanThof

- Committee meeting held to support Bond Vote
- Proposed request to expend up to \$5000 of Global funds
 - Currently have \$14,000 before any expenditures discussed this evening
 - PTSA said they would be willing to help expend some funds to do this
 - PTSA at their own elementary meetings are presenting this information
 - Cost for advertising last year was \$2000
- George Haefner was asked to help committee with ideas and actions to help get the word out for the Facilities Project Vote.
- Contacted Jim Roth regarding advertising in Penfield Post
 - ¼ page ad \$375
 - ½ page ad \$1500
 - ¼ editorial plus ½ page ad following week \$1800
 - Needs to be written by Wednesday prior
 - Full-page proof done by Nov 1, published just before November vote.
- Signage
 - Stickers printed up to cover and change date
 - Need 40 more with new sign idea
 - George will email Debbie with information that I can send out to the group
- Feels an additional committee may be needed
- Would like 5000 door hangers (Wednesday before weekend prior to vote)
 - Sunday do door hanger presentation
 - Get kids out in the neighborhood to put them on doors
- Susanne Perrone will get data base to make calls to remind people to vote
 - Get database from Nancy Bradstreet?
 - Use independent dialer to make the calls
- Speak to Kevin Williams or Steve Hausman (?) to do voice-over for PCTV
- Tom motioned we move November meeting to Nov 13
 - Mick seconded

VICE PRESIDENT: Mick Schoenberger

- Looked at various hosting packages
- Found a hosting package from Network Solutions for \$159/year
 - Can have up to 1000 pages with this package
- Did search on possible domain names
 - Will meet with committee soon
- Met with Pete to discuss some things we can do
 - Want team web pages to link to this site
 - Fundraising
 - Information sharing
 - Access to forms for participation in athletics
- Mick made a motion proposing that we develop and maintain a Penfield Patriots Booster Website
 - Don Hoyler seconded
 - Tom motioned that we add the \$159 cost
 - Patty seconded

SECRETARY: Deb Weigand

- Waiting for list of tax-exempt vendors from Chuck

TREASURER: Chuck Fogle

- Distributed financial statements asking everyone to check for accuracy
- Chuck needs to be given as much notice as possible to get payments sent out
- Do not drop off check requests at school, mail them to his home

STUDENT REP: Matt Plakosh - no report

VARSITY CLUB REP: not selected yet

COMMITTEE CHAIR REPORTS:

CONCESSIONS: Marie Mahany (not present), Barb Babiarz, and Anand Choudri (not present)

- **Anand will do the lottery at 7pm prior to the meeting on Nov 13.**
- Barb Babiarz requested that cheerleading be guaranteed a Basketball game to do concessions rather than be put in the lottery.
 - Tom VanThof motioned that Cheerleading get a Basketball game (Boy's BB first, Girl's BB second, and then cheerleading)
 - Tom Peffley seconded
 - Voted and approved
- Again mentioned that Volleyball could be doing their own concessions

FUNDRAISING: Patty Vermilion and Sue DelPozzo

- Sue and Patty met and looked at the By-Laws
 - Winter: SCRIP
 - Spring: Golf Tournament
- Calendar has not been kept to show committee what each team is doing for fundraising for their own team.
 - Perhaps keep track of this on new website?
- Copy of order form for SCRIP will be published in the PHS Observer and Trailblazer
 - Can just take orders or buy a supply of cards to sell right at the next Parent/Athlete meeting

MEMBERSHIP: Kathy Meyer and Marilina Shaughnessy

- Currently 126 families registered.
- Kathy has a list of all families registered so far
 - Deb will forward this list
- Chuck still has some registrations

FACILITIES: Jim Howe

- Swim Team's proposal includes:
 - The purchase of 3 new 30" x 40" reversible rolling white boards for \$420 each
 - Pace clocks; 2 wall clocks @ \$272, portable clock @ \$351
- Swimming/Diving Boosters received some funding from Sea Dragons and Penfield Rec
 - Receiving \$1150 from these contributions and are asking for \$1200 (total \$2350)
- Jim recommends we go ahead with this proposal.
- Susan Perrone motioned we accept this proposal
 - Patty V seconded
 - Unanimous vote

ATHLETIC DIRECTOR: Pete Shambo

- Nov 21 is winter Parent/Athlete meeting
- For Bond Vote, need to get Prop 1 passed first
 - We need Prop 1 to make Prop 2 most effective
 - There won't be an exit survey this time – gives it a negative feel
 - There have always been 1200 NO votes regardless of the proposals
 - We need to generate 1200 YES votes at the very least
 - Not specific to athletes, but to the community
 - Don't pay for use of school facilities – should let people know this
 - We need to share information on how to sign up for STAR
 - Pete suggests we don't "fuel the fire" by arguing with people who have their mind made up to vote NO

OLD BUSINESS:

- Facilities vote
 - Tom V motioned we spend \$5000 of Global funds to support the Facilities vote
 - Tim Harris seconded
 - Vote – majority voted YES
 - Discussed coming up with list of other organizations that are willing to put their name down as supporting the vote.

NEW BUSINESS:

- No new business
