Meeting was called to order at 7:35 p.m.

SPEAKER: School Board Rep Karin Wilson

Karin discussed the latest Facilities Project information

At its Sept. 19th meeting, the Penfield Board of Education set Nov. 14, 2006 as the date for a public vote on the district's revised facilities project. The revised project was developed after several months of input from the community, parents, and staff. In response to public input, the project has been significantly reduced in both scope and cost and focuses on the district's most immediate facilities issues. The proposal has also been broken up into three propositions in response to voter request for choices. The Base Proposition must pass before Proposition #2 and/or Proposition #3 can pass.

The three propositions are as follows:

Base Proposition (Proposition #1): This proposition includes renovations and additions at all six district schools. The majority of the work is focused on Bay Trail Middle School and Penfield High School. It includes classroom additions and renovations, heating and ventilation work, changes to meet ADA regulations, and traffic safety improvements, among other items. Total cost of this proposition is \$62,347,800.

Proposition #2: This proposition focuses on athletic field work at Penfield High School. It includes the installation of an artificial turf field in the stadium, as well as the replacement of the existing bleachers and scorekeepers' box, and additional storage space. The addition of a restroom to serve the athletic facilities is also included in this proposition. Total cost of this proposition is \$1,856,100.

Proposition #3: This proposition focuses on kitchen renovations at all six school buildings. These renovations include replacing aging kitchen equipment, adding fire suppression systems at some schools, replacing ceiling tiles, replacing electrical, ventilation and plumbing systems. Total cost of this proposition is \$1,966,100.

The District will receive 70 cents for every dollar spent on portions of the project that are eligible for state aid.

Detailed information regarding the revised proposal will be mailed to voters in October. **A public information meeting is being held at 7 pm Oct. 12 in the Penfield High School Commons.**
